

Boyer informed those present that the meeting has been duly advertised to address the Boroughs intention to file a grant application with the Community Development Block Grant program for the reconstruction of East Sixth Street between Washington Street and the Borough East Boundary, and Arlington Street. The application will be filed with the Montgomery County Department of Housing and Community Development, and conduct any other business that may come before Council.

Atty. B. Tomlinson presented Council with Resolution 2010-05 which authorizes the Borough to make application to the Montgomery County Department of Housing and Community Development for a grant in the amount of \$ 125,928.00 for the reconstruction of East Sixth Street from Washington Street to the East Borough Line and Arlington Street. On a motion by Ms. Thomson and a second by Mr. Pugh, which passed, Council approved filing grant application.

OTHER BUSINESS:


