**A RESOLUTION OF THE EAST GREENVILLE BOROUGH
COUNCIL AMENDING THE EMERGENCY OPERATIONS PLAN
FOR BOROUGH OF EAST GREENVILLE.**

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, Section 7503 of the Pennsylvania Emergency Management Services Code, 35, PA S.S.A. Section 7101 et seq. mandates that the East Greenville Borough prepare, maintain and keep current an emergency operations plan for the prevention and minimization of injury and damage caused by a major emergency or disaster within this Borough; and


WHEREAS, on January 3, 2012, by Resolution No. 2012- 03, in response to the mandate stated above, this Borough adopted an emergency operations plan to provide prompt and effective emergency response procedures to be followed in the event of a major emergency or disaster and to reduce the potential effects of a major emergency or disaster and to protect the health, safety and welfare of the residents of this Borough; and

WHEREAS, the Borough has conducted a thorough review of its emergency operation plan so adopted and its Appendices to the plan, setting forth evacuation routes, designating risk institutions and listing the names of non-ambulatory, sight and hearing impaired persons should be attached to the plan;


NOW, THEREFORE, we the undersigned, the Mayor and the President of the East Greenville Borough Council, do hereby approve, adopt, and place into immediate effect the Emergency Operations Plan of East Greenville Borough, as amended. This plan shall be reviewed on a bi-annual basis to make certain that it conforms to the requirements of the Montgomery County Emergency Operations Plan.

RESOLVED, this 3rd day of January, 2012.


