Council Pres. Pro Tem, Jennifer Boyer called a SPECIAL MEETING of East Greenville Borough Council to order at 7:30p.m. The meeting was opened with the Pledge of Allegiance. Answering the roll call were: Gary Bilger, Jennifer Boyer, Josiah Pierson and Marita Thomson. Also present were: Donald W Huff, James Fry, Atty. Tomlinson, 4 visitors and 1 member of the press.

Ms. Boyer informed everyone that the meeting has been duly advertised to conduct a Public Hearing on the Boroughs intention to file a joint application with Upper Hanover Township and Red Hill Borough for the purchase of Open Space in the area of Peevy Road. The application will be filed with the Montgomery County Open Space Board. The Borough may also conduct any other business that comes before it.

Atty Tomlinson asked if anyone had any comments or questions. Hearing none Ms. Boyer called for a motion to adopt **RESOLUTION 2009-08. RESOLUTION 2009-08** approves filing a grant application with the Montgomery County Open Space Board along with Upper Hanover Township and Red Hill Borough to purchase property in the area of Peevy Road that will be preserved as Open Space. On a motion by Ms. Thomson and a second by Mr. Pierson, which passed, Council adopted Resolution 2009-08.

Ms. Boyer called for a motion to adopt **RESOLUTION 2009-09. RESOLUTION 2009-09** approved filing an application for a grant with the Montgomery County Open Space Board to develop the Boroughs Tot Lot at 3<sup>rd</sup> Street and Blaker Drive. The grant is for more recreational facilities, walking paths, seating, etc. Mr. Fry noted that the plan we will submit is Plan D from Cowan Associates. The application dead line is March 31, 2009 by 4:00p.m. We will let the board know that the plan is subject to change depending what come about with the CVA offer. Mr. McMackin of Cowan Associates feels that the CVA is a few months behind us, and he agreed that we can modify the plan at a later date. On a motion by Ms. Thomson and a second by Mr. Pierson, which passed, Council approved filing the grant application.

There being no further business Ms. Boyer adjourned the meeting at 7:43p.m.
